

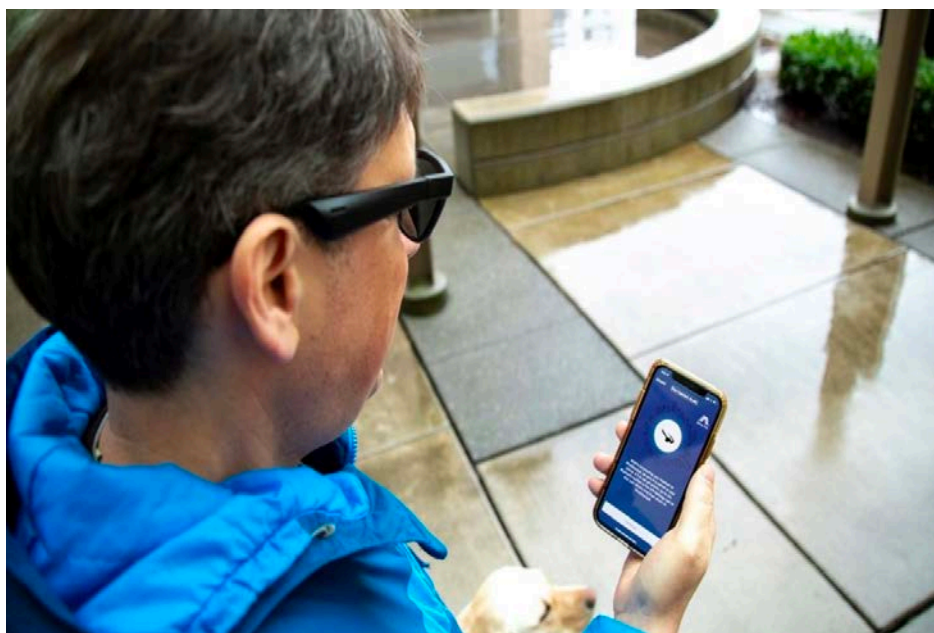
# Introducing Microsoft Soundscape.

## What is Microsoft Soundscape?

Microsoft Soundscape is a free app (only available for iPhone) specifically designed to support people who are blind or have low vision to navigate their world with the assistance of 3D audio.

Microsoft Soundscape uses innovative audio-based technology to enable people with blindness or low vision to build a richer awareness of their surroundings, becoming more confident and empowered to get around.

## For the parents

This one-off introductory group session is designed for primary and secondary school-aged students, as well as their parents and/or guardians, who are interested in learning about Microsoft Soundscape and how to apply the app's features to best support the user's orientation and mobility (O&M).

## Requirements

Participants will need to have access to an iPhone 6 or newer, with Microsoft Soundscape pre-loaded, and a set of headphones and or earphones.

Sessions are conducted via Zoom, where you will be connecting with other participants in a fun and safe online environment.
