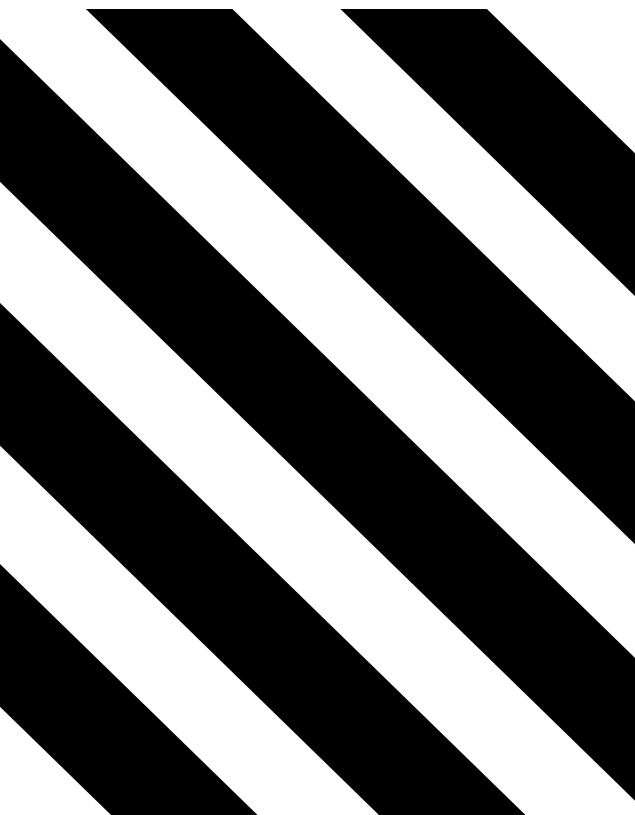

## Services for all ages and levels of vision

We support people of any age and level of vision loss. Depending on your personal situation, we can tailor the services to your needs. You or someone you care about may be diagnosed with, but certainly not limited to:

- Glaucoma
- Diabetic Eye Disease
- Acquired Brain Injury
- Cortical Vision Impairment (CVI)
- Age-Related Macular Degeneration
- Hereditary Vision Loss, e.g. Retinitis Pigmentosa

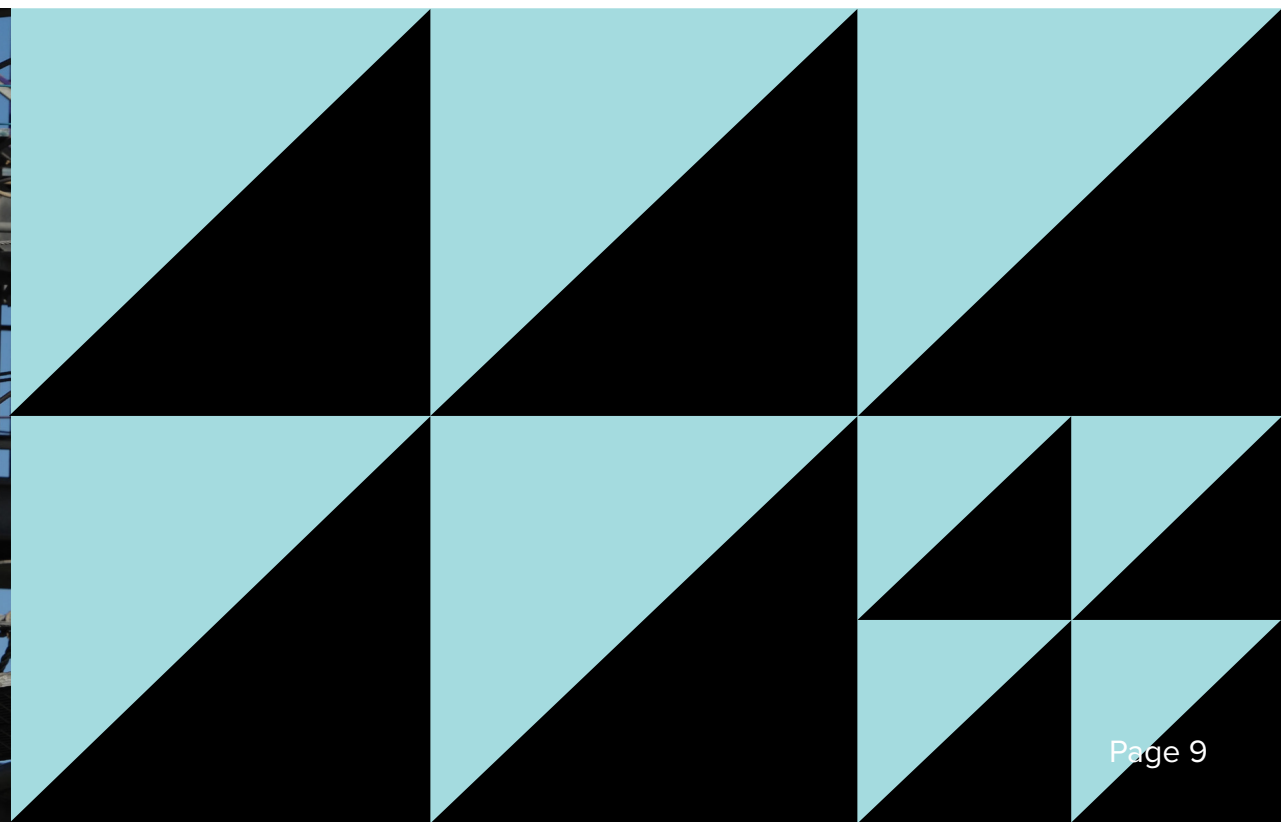
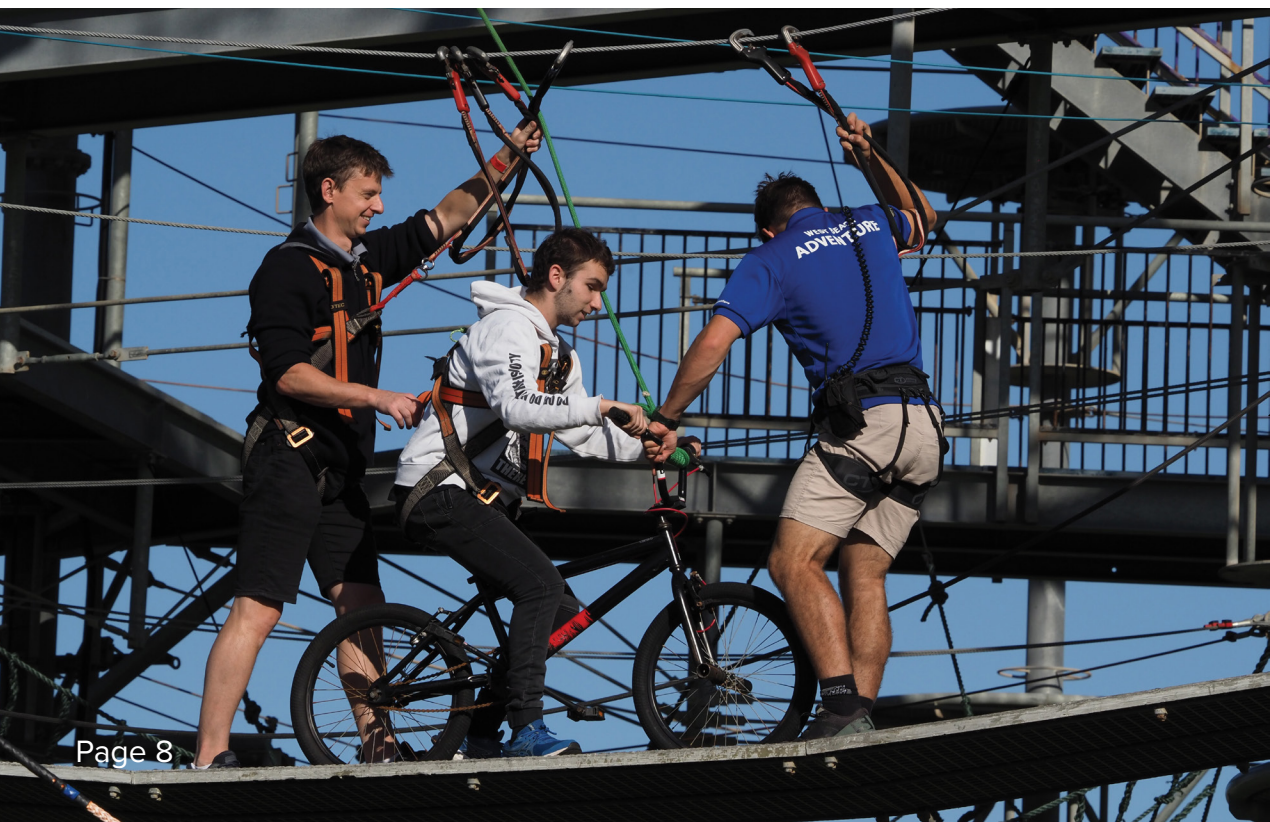
## What funding is available?

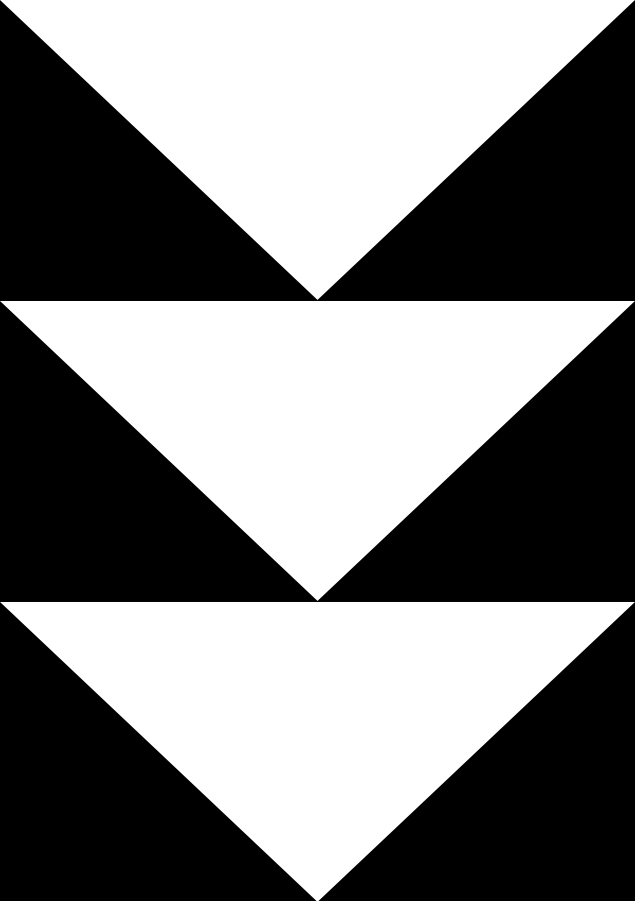
